Taking Note of Foreign Languages

The grant funded purchase of

- 1. French, Italian, and Spanish DVDs to comply with close captioning requirements;
- 2. Class sets of readers for the above languages;
- Two Livescribe Echo smart pens to be used by students with learning disabilities or challenges taking notes during traditional lectures.

<u>Outcome</u>: The project purchased five films per language and 10 readers per language. In addition, two smart pens, cases and chargers were purchased.

students in the program, enriching the delivery of the required curriculum. The smart pens were piloted in several Spanish classes this year.
