For those in the industry that do know, these STRAHMAN pistol grip nozzles are THE industry standard that cannot be overlooked or under-valued.

These STRAHMAN sprayers are professional grade spray nozzles that have proven their worth over, and over again from the moment they went into service! We purchased the spray nozzles to help improve instruction on winery sanitation protocols and the results have been wonderful. If you visit any working winery, this is the type of equipment you would find in use. If you were employed by the winery, these are the spray nozzles you would be using. They are amazing!
